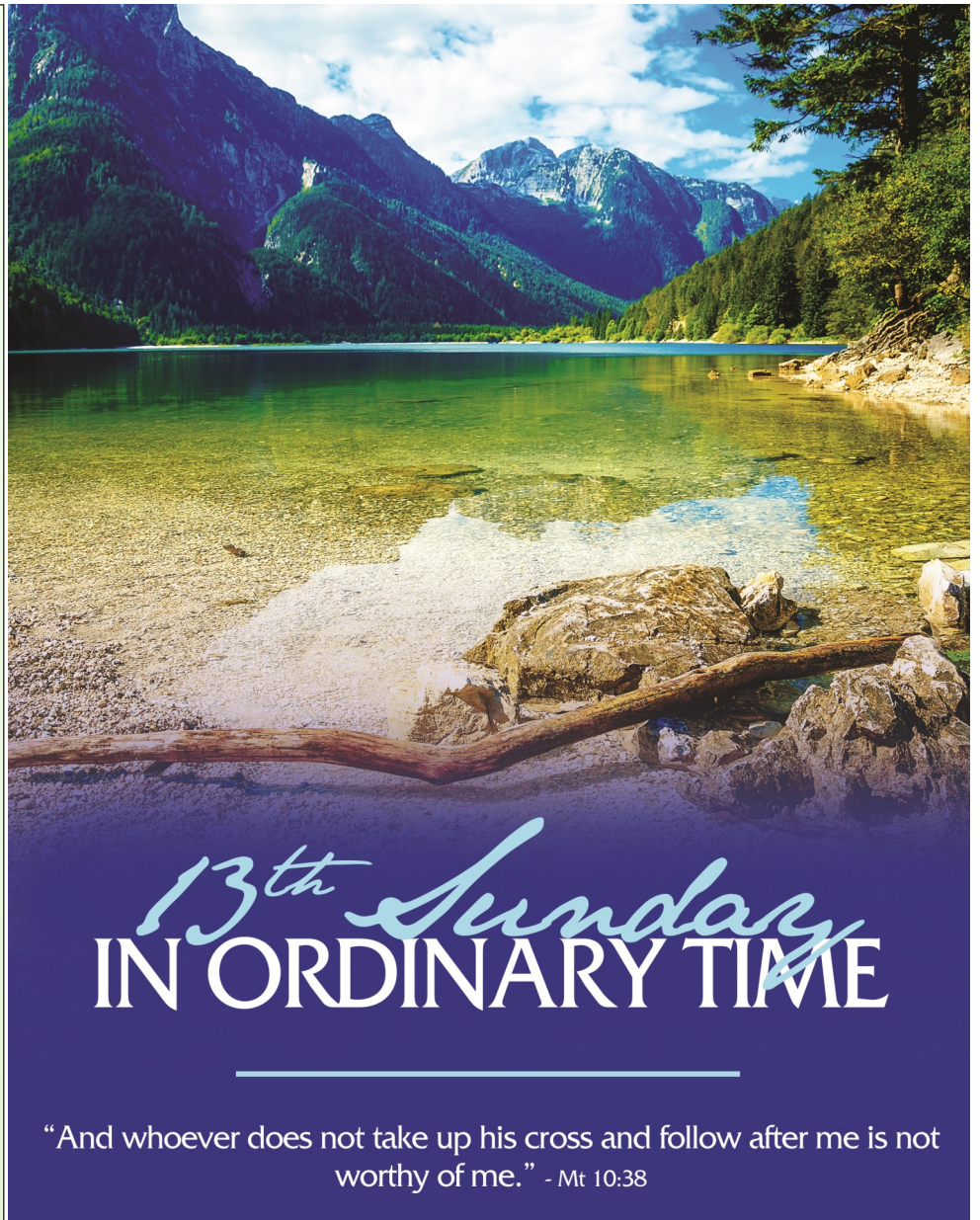

1. Go to **www.yourcclc.org**
2. Click on the church link to load the church of your choice, ie: St. Mary's or St. Vincent's.
3. Along the top ribbon, click on the "Giving" button and then select your church button.
4. The web page for the payment web page will load.
5. If you have never used this service before, look for "New Users" and select "Register Here" to create an account.
6. If a returning customer, "Login" for new transactions or to view payment history.

## CCLC Reopening Plan & Dates

### Guidelines for Reopening CCLC Parish Offices

**St. Mary's**

- Parish office will resume business under normal operating hours M 2-4, Tu 10-2, W 10-7, Th 2-4, F closed
- Entry will be through the west door of the parish office which will remain locked as in the past.
- Ring the doorbell for access to the office area. The east door will remain locked.
- Proper social distancing should always be adhered to as much as possible. Hand sanitizer and disinfectant will be available inside the door upon entering the office area. Signage will be posted informing people to disinfect the door handles and sanitize their hands after entering. Hand sanitizer will also be available in the administration office.
- The individual men's and women's restrooms will be closed, but the unisex restroom will remain open. The restroom should only be used by non-staff on an emergency basis.
- Disinfectant and wipes will be available in the restroom for user to disinfect. Hand sanitizer will also be available. The basement area will be closed to the public.

**St. Vincent de Paul**

- Parish office will resume business under normal operating hours M thru F 9-4
- Entry will be through the front door (east side) of the parish office. The west door will remain locked with exceptions for ADA access when needed and during weekday Masses for restroom access.
- Proper social distancing should always be adhered to as much as possible.
- Hand sanitizer and disinfectant will be available inside both the east and west doors upon entering the office area. Signage will be posted informing people to disinfect the door handles and sanitize their hands after entering.
- Use of the conference room should be limited to the number of people that can maintain proper social distancing
- After using the conference room, the top of the table and wood handles (not cloth) on the chairs and the door handles should be disinfected by the user of the room. Disinfectant and wipes will be available in the room. Hand sanitizer will also be available
- The first-floor restrooms should only be used by non-staff on an emergency basis. Disinfectant and wipes will be available in the restrooms for user to disinfect.
- The Adoration Chapel will remain closed to the public until further notice
- The second-floor restrooms and kitchen area should only be used by parish staff.
- The copy machine should have hand sanitizer available for use.
- All parish offices should have hand sanitizer available for use.

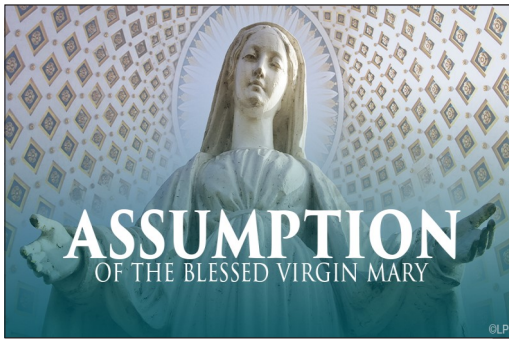

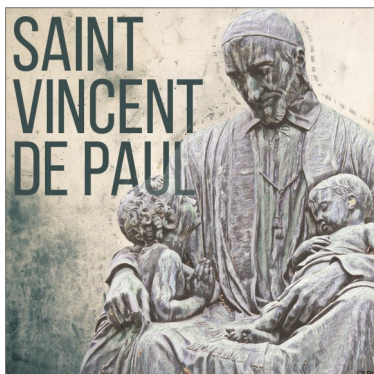
